9th - 10th Grade Dramatic Arts 1

2 Semesters 1 Credit
The foundation for high school theatre begins with Dramatic Arts I. The student will find an orientation to the dramatic skills necessary to develop his/her creative talents. Each student will be given an opportunity to participate in creative dramatics in order to secure a basic understanding and critical appreciation of the theatre art.

10th - 12th Grade Dramatic Arts II

2 Semesters 1 Credit
Requirements and Limitations: Dramatic Arts I and permission of the instructor.

The student who begins this course should have a basic understanding of the fundamentals of theatre and plan to develop those skills in production. To assist the student in his growth, a variety of skill activities will be used. Among them will be duo scenes, elements of play writing, improvisation, physical movement and vocal technique.

10th - 12th Grade Dramatic Arts III

2 Semesters 1 Credit
Requirements and Limitations: Dramatic Arts II and permission of the instructor.

As a member of this advanced drama course, the student will be asked to expand his creative talents with a focus on the works of Shakespeare, objective criticism, acting methods, and play production. From this class two productions will be performed, one each semester. The students will be exposed to a variety of guest artists who will help them expand their God given talent.

10th - 12th Grade Dramatic Arts IV

2 Semesters 1 Credit
Requirements and Limitations: Dramatic Arts III and permission of the instructor.

In the second year of advanced drama the student will become part of a production crew that will be responsible for the development and performance of two productions, one each semester. The focus will be on the literature related to the methods of acting. Specific exercises along with guest artists will help students develop their talents in a creative environment.

10th - 12th Grade Dramatic Arts -VISIONS

2 Semesters 1 Credit
Requirements and Limitations: Audition and interview with the instructor are mandatory for admission. Class limited to 14 students.

Visions is a dramatic ensemble designed to develop the students' skills in the three areas of performing arts: drama, music, and dance. The students will be furnished with an opportunity to enrich their performance skills by participation in a variety of venues. This enables the students to increase the depth of their creative talents.

10th - 12th Grade

Dramatic Arts – Theatre Direction/Technical Theatre

1 Semester

½ Credit

Requirements and Limitations: Interview with the instructor is mandatory for admission.

The Technical Theatre class focusing on directing will have the student director follow the directing process from start to finish. Students will select their script, audition cast, rehearse the scenes, and produce the play. The Technical Theatre class, focusing on lighting, sound, and set construction, will also be available to interested theatre students
